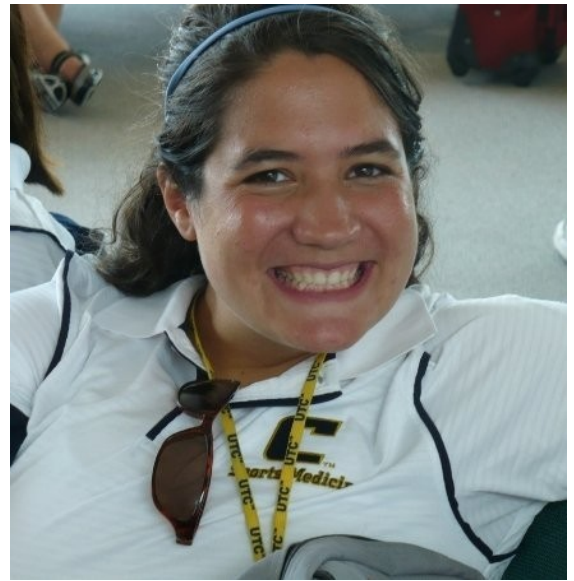


WHY WE TRI
